FRAMEWORK FOR FAIR, EQUITABLE AND TIMELY ALLOCATION OF COVID-19 VACCINES IN AFRICA

As part of implementing the Africa's Joint Continental Strategy to combat COVID-19, the Africa Centres for Disease Control and Prevention, in partnership with the South African Medical Research Council, will host a virtual conference to discuss Africa's leadership role in enabling the development, access and equity to a COVID-19 vaccine.

This virtual conference will bring together healthcare professionals, researchers, public health experts, policy makers, and more to deliberate on how barriers to widespread delivery and uptake of effective COVID-19 vaccines across Africa are to be addressed and eradicated while drawing from African norms and principles.
